### READING/ELA

- If I were a snowman....? Write a story about your experiences if you were a snowman for a day.
- -Use salt, sugar, flour, or something similar on a baking sheet and write some words (ch words, sh, magic e, rhyming words)
- -Write a thank you note to your mail carrier.
- -Help a family member make a grocery list of items your family needs to purchase at the store.

#### MATH

- Ask members of your family what snow activities are their favorite. (Sledding, snowball fights, building a snowman)Call grandparents and friends, if possible. Make tally marks for their votes. Challenge: Make a bar graph to show your results.
- -If you have a piggy bank or your family has a coin jar, sort the coins by value. Add up the pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters to find the total.
- -Choose an object and do some measuring with it. (my room is 18 shoes long, my mom is 6 shoes long)

## JUST FOR FUN

- Sit a cup of water on your porch. Record the time. Check in two hours. Describe the change that occurred. Now bring it back inside. How long does it take for it to return to its original state?
- -Go outside and blow frozen bubbles.
