READING/ELA

- Read your favorite book or an article with a family member and model how to be a wise reader by asking questions before, during, and after you read. Explain how it helps to better understand the text.
- Write an acrostic poem for the words "snow" or "winter". An example of an acrostic poem would be: Soft drifts, never-ending blizzard, outside wonderland, winter's white blanket
- What is your favorite and least favorite chore that you have to do at your house. Write a paragraph describing them both.
- Choose 5 multi-meaning words. Write two sentences for each word. Be sure each sentence uses the word with a different definition. For example: (deck) My dad built a new deck on the back of the house. My brother played with a deck of cards.
- "I am not at school today" This is a cause. Name 5 fun effects that could happen because you are not at school. Now use "I am not at school" today as the effect. What are 5 funny reasons you may not be at school today? Remember to use conjunctions!

MATH

- Go around the house and find equal groups of something, example chair legs, write an equation and solve.
- Draw an array in the snow -below the array write the number sentence that includes the product.

- What is your house number? Write it in word form and expanded form. Round it to the nearest 10 and nearest 100. What is 10 more, 10 less? What is 100 more, 100 less? Draw a picture of your house.
- You have 30 cookies in a new box of Thin Mints. How many cookies does each person in your home get, if you divide them evenly? Will you have any left over? Make your own story problem using division.

JUST FOR FUN

- Does snow sink or float? Write what you think will happen before you try the experiment. Then make 2 snowballs one that is packed tightly and one that is loosely packed. Write what happens to both of the snowballs when you place them in a bowl of water.
- Make a snow volcano with the following ingredients: 2 spoonfuls of baking soda, 1 spoonful of dish soap, a few drops of food coloring, 30 ml of vinegar, snow, and a small container.
 1. Take the container and place it into the ground.
 2. Build up snow around the container. Keep the opening free of snow and pack the snow tightly.
 3. Add everything to the container except the vinegar.
 4. Add the vinegar when you're ready for the eruptions.
 5. Stand back and enjoy!
- Make snow angels inside for some exercise! (if it's not too cold go outside!)
