READING/ELA

- Write "at" "og" "ed" word family words in the snow.
- Beginning sound hunt: Write the alphabet down and write down items in house that start with each letter.
- Draw pictures of the sequence of events of your day and tell someone about them. Ex. 1 get out of bed, 2 get dressed, 3 eat breakfast, etc.
- Play "I Spy" (beginning sounds) My little eye spies something that starts like /ch/. Answer- chair, chips, chain, choo choo. . .
- Read a favorite story and ask who are the characters? Setting? What happened 1st, 2nd or 3rd?

MATH

- Walk out your front or back door and walk to the street or end of your driveway with adult supervision. Count your snow prints.
- Measure one cup of cereal such as Cheerios or Fruit Loops. Count the number of pieces in your cup or at least to 100. Then have a snack!
- Find one shoe from each person in your family and line them up in order from shortest to longest. How many of the shortest shoes would it take to make the longest?
- Practice adding/subtracting snowballs.

JUST FOR FUN

- Snow melt: collect three different 1 cup fulls of snow. Place them in different areas (kitchen sink, in the shade, in the sun, etc...) Set a timer, draw pictures or write your observations after 5 min, 15 min, and 30 min. Note any changes. Is one melting faster, slower, the same?
- Feed the birds- scatter bread, cookies, crackers on the ground. Draw pictures of the different kinds of birds that come. Record your observations: how many birds, how many different kinds, how fast did they eat the food, etc...
- Write a thank you note to someone that helps your community.
- Jump as many times in 1 minute as you can!
