

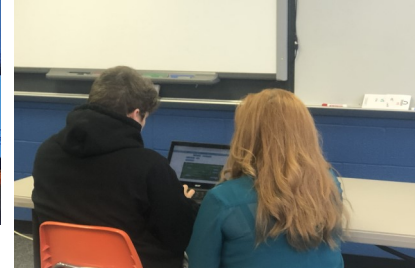
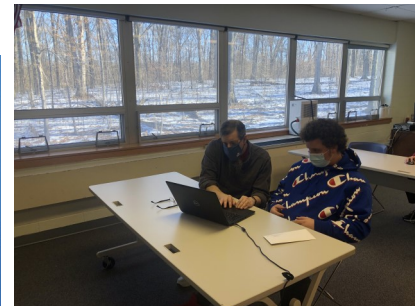


# GATEWAY ACADEMY
