NORTH LAWRENCE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ORIGINAL PLAN OF SCHOOL REORGANIZATION

WHEREAS, the City limits of Bedford have changed several times since the adoption of the original plan of school reorganization: and,

WHEREAS some school board districts need to be redefined to clarify boundaries;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Article III., School Board Member Residence Districts, of the comprehensive plan of reorganization of North Lawrence Community Schools be amended by deleting the current language defining Districts numbers 3, 4 and 5 and replacing the language in the current plan as follows:

District No. Three (3) shall include Guthrie Civil Township and all of that part of Shawswick Civil Township that lies east of the following line, to-wit: Commencing at the intersection of the Bartlettsville Road with the north line of Shawswick Township; thence south along the center line of the Bartlettsville Road to its intersection with State Road No. 58; thence in a southwesterly direction along the center line of State Road No. 58 to the eastern line of the corporate limits of the City of Bedford (as the same currently exists and may from time to time be amended and redefined by annexation); thence in southerly and easterly direction along the said corporate limit line to White River.

District No. Four (4) shall include all of the corporate limits of the Civil City of Bedford as it currently exists and may from time to time be amended and redefined by

· • annexation; excepting therefrom all of the Civil City of Bedford lying West of the Center line of State Road 37.

District No. Five (5) shall include all of the remaining territory in Shawswick Civil Township, outside the City of Bedford that lies west of the line described in District #3 and all of that part of the Civil City of Bedford lying west of the center line of State Road 37.

WHEREAS, the qualifications of school board members set by Indiana statutes have changed since the adoption of the original plan of school reorganization; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees desires that the plan of reorganization of North Lawrence Community Schools be in compliance with Indiana Statutes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Article VI., Qualification of Board of School Trustees be amended by deleting all the current language of Article VI and replacing it as follows:

VI. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES

A school board member, when elected, shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. School board members shall have resided in the school corporation and their respective residence districts for at least one (1) year before their election. Property ownership is not a qualification.

Adopted in open session this 22nd day of September, 2005 by unanimous vote.
