ABOUT US

Bedford North Lawrence High School is located just to the east of the town of Bedford, Indiana, in Lawrence County. The school opened in January of 1975 as the result of the consolidation of seven schools. The high school has an enrollment of approximately 1,400 students in grades nine through twelve. The school is part of the North Lawrence Community School Corporation, which serves approximately 4,500 students from the portion of the county north of White River. Bedford itself has slightly over 13,000 residents and Lawrence County has a population of over 45,000 individuals. Lawrence County is located in south-central Indiana, about 70 miles south of Indianapolis at the crossroads of S.R. 37 and U.S. 50.

Bedford North Lawrence High School is the Home of the STARS. Each school day, BNL transforms itself into one of the area's larger communities, with about 1,400 students and over 100 faculty and staff to meet their curricular and extra-curricular needs. We take great pride in having achieved the status of an Indiana Four Star School.

We look forward to this school year as another opportunity to embrace the changes that come about not only in the lives of our students but also in the landscape of public education in Indiana and our nation. A constant in this changing environment is our mission to ensure that every student works to complete requirements for graduation, developing skills necessary for college, careers, and life.



ACADEMICS

The academic programs at BNL are designed to help students think critically, engage purposively, and be prepared to influence the wider world positively. Students have access to college preparatory, honors, and university-level courses in all major subject areas. This includes more than 30 available college credits through Advanced Placement courses and numerous dual-credit classes through partnerships with Vincennes University, Indiana University, Ivy Tech, and University of Southern Indiana.

Bedford is a resourceful community, and BNL has worked hard to foster our relationships with local partners to extend learning beyond our campus. We also offer an extensive internship program that allows students to earn course credit for work completed at job sites throughout town. Past placements have included medical facilities, city government, local charities, and small businesses.

BNL shares a campus with North Lawrence Career Center, and our students can sign-up to study skilled trades. From welding to agriculture to auto mechanics, NLCC programs prepare students for employment and often lead to industry certification. Both BNL and NLCC participate in Project Lead the Way, a renowned program for engineering and health sciences.

Students are assigned a Chromebook and Google Classroom platform for the entire year. The computers serve as a transformational classroom tool for the students to create content.
