The Early College program allows students to complete courses at BNL and receive both high school and college credit for their work. The program provides students with extensive support so they can succeed in high school, college and beyond.

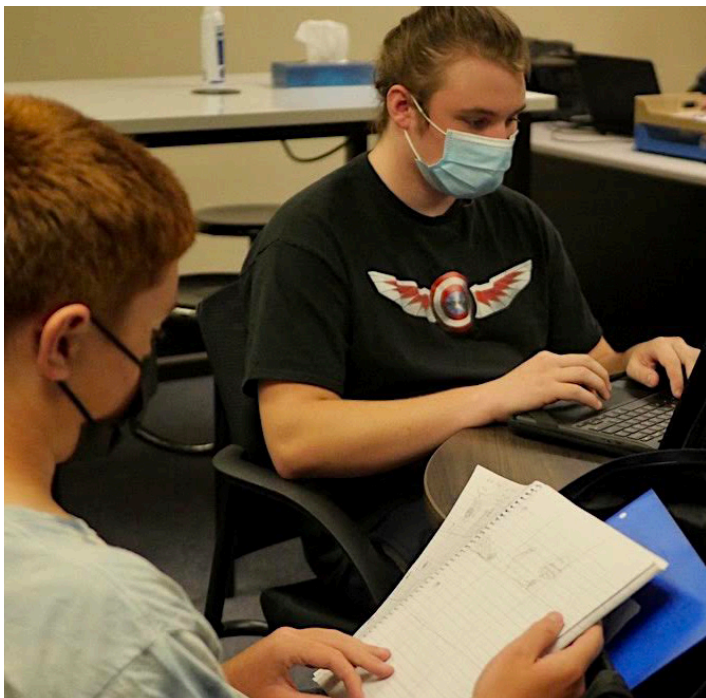

Students can earn the Indiana College Core through dual credit in high school and save a lot of money and time!

Signing up

Students from grades 8-11 are invited to apply for Early College! Students can apply to the BNL Early College program starting in their 8th grade year while planning their 9th grade course schedule. Applying for Early College in 8th grade or early in your high school career helps students plan out their Indiana College Core requirements into their yearly academic schedule.

Program length

Every student's experience is different based on their interests, strengths, and goals. Some students will work to complete their ICC credits all four years, while students who join the program later may only work towards their ICC requirements over 2-3 years.
