



Springville Elementary School Supply List

Kindergarten

Your child will need:

- A backpack (WITHOUT WHEELS!) EVERY day (If he leaves it at Grandma's, he needs to bring a sack to carry his things in!)
- A clean, white T-shirt that will be big enough to fit over his clothes through the school year.
- A small container to hold his reward pennies (pencil pouch, etc.)
- A towel with his name on it (to be used at rest time; must be smaller enough to fit in a 10" x 17" drawstring bag that we provide)
- Ten paper 2-pocket folders with 3 prongs (solid color, no name written on them; your child will not necessarily be using the folders she brings)

Optional things you may choose to donate:

- A box of Kleenexes
- A disposable camera (good for inside OR outside)
- A box of baggies (We will need all sizes.)
- A package of paper plates (We use both large and small sizes.)
- A package of paper plates, Styrofoam, or plastic cups
- Developing the disposable cameras
- Disinfecting wipes

1st Grade

1. Six (6) glue sticks
 2. Fiskar scissors
 3. Six (6) #2 pencils
 4. Six (6) pencil-top erasers
 5. School box (cardboard or plastic), not too big; (5" x 8" size is fine).
 6. Large eraser
 7. Box of 16 or 24 crayons
 8. One (1) box of 8 pack crayons - To keep at home for math lessons/math homework.
 9. Box of Snack Size baggies
 10. Box of Sandwich Size baggies
 11. Box of Gallon Size baggies
 12. One (1) easy to read, non -flexible ruler (centimeters and inches)
 13. Three Packages of Index Cards
 14. Book bag or backpack
 15. One small pack of dry-erase wipe-off board markers.

16. Two (2) 2-pocket folders
 17. Two (2) boxes of Kleenex
 18. Headphones (Dollar Tree for a \$1.00)

4. One (1) Package of pencil top erasers
5. School box (Regular size to fit in desk)
6. Large eraser
7. Two (2) packs of 24 Crayola crayons
8. Four 2-pocket folders
9. One ruler (centimeters and inches) - No bendable rulers
10. Book bag or backpack
11. Scissors
12. Two (2) boxes of Kleenex
