admire — think very highly of something

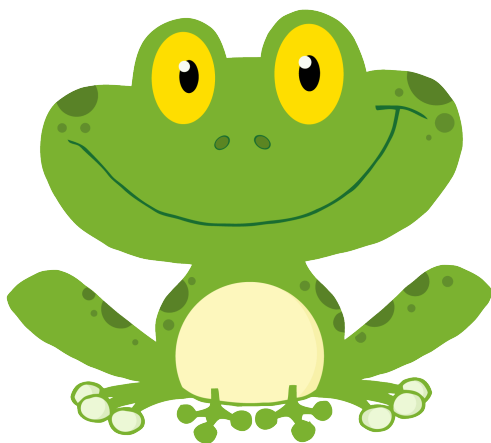
jumble — mix things up
